<b>Questa Loan Program</b>	This is a LOAN PROGRAM designed to keep students living and working in NE Indiana after graduation. Students must first qualify as a Questa Scholar. Then they must graduate from college with a GPA of 2.75 or higher. Upon graduation, 25% of the loan is forgiven. An additional 25% will be forgiven if the graduate lives and works in NE Indiana for five years after graduation. Up to 75% of the loan will be forgiven if certain criteria are met.
