Fall

- Review and update your four-year plan.
- Remember that all grades, test scores and attendance are part of your permanent record.
- Maintain your involvement in extra-curricular activities. Work toward leadership positions in the activities you enjoy the most.
- Take challenging courses.
- Remain focused on your academic goals and build upon your GPA.
- Take the PSAT in October. The PSAT is a preliminary test that will prepare you for the SAT Reasoning Test.

Spring

- Review your PSAT test results with your guidance counselor.
- Become familiar with NCAA rules and take NCAA-approved courses if you want to play sports in college.
- Keep a record of your co-curricular involvement, volunteer work, and employment.
- Save your best work in academic courses for your academic portfolio.
- Prepare for the Core 40 End-of-Course Assessments in English 10, Biology, and Algebra I, which will be administered in May. Passing grades on the English 10 and Algebra I ECA's are required for graduation in the State of Indiana.
